Denaro falso (in russo: Фальшивый купон?, traslitterato: Fal'shivyi kupon) è un racconto in due parti di Lev Tolstoj, ideato alla fine degli anni ottanta del XIX secolo, composto non prima del 1904 e pubblicato postumo nel 1911. Il racconto è diviso in due parti: nella prima la falsificazione di un titolo di credito di piccolo valore, fatta da due studenti, innesca una catena di eventi che coinvolgono decine di altre persone, con conseguenze sempre più gravi; nella seconda parte viene offerta una possibilità di redenzione alla maggior parte dei protagonisti superstiti. Prima parte: Mitja, uno studente ginnasiale di quindici anni, deve restituire sei rubli a un suo amico. Poiché suo padre gli nega un anticipo sulla paghetta mensile, Mitja si rivolge a Mächin, un altro suo compagno di scuola con precoce tendenza alla dissolutezza; costui gli suggerisce di impegnare l'orologio e falsificare poi la cedola del monte dei pegni. Mitja impegna il suo orologio, mette poi un "1" davanti alla cifra di 2,50 rubli sulla cedola e, con l'aiuto

di Màchin, utilizza la cedola falsificata per acquistare in un negozio di prodotti fotografici una cornice del valore di 1,50 rubli e ottenere da Màrja Vasìljevna, la moglie fiduciosa e ingenua del proprietario Jevghènij Michàjlovic, undici rubli di resto. Jevghènij Michàjlovic, accortosi del falso, utilizza fraudolentemente la cedola per acquistare della legna da Ivàn Mirònov, un povero contadino. Accusato di aver spacciato una cedola falsificata, Mirònov indica alla polizia colui che gliel'aveva rifilata; ma Jevghènij, grazie anche alla falsa testimonianza del portiere Vasìlij da lui corrotto, lo denuncia per calunnia e Mirònov viene condannato. Avendo appreso quali vantaggi possano derivare dalle azioni disoneste, Vasìlij inizia a compiere piccoli furti e perde il lavoro. Anche Ivàn Mirònov, il quale da queste vicissitudini ha ricavato la morale che «tutti i signori vivono solamente derubando il prossimo», col corollario che «i signori meritano di essere derubati», si dedica al furto ai danni di proprietari e di mercanti. Mirònov viene identificato come autore di un furto di cavalli ai danni di Pjotr Nikolàjevic Sventìtskij, un ricco imprenditore agricolo. Mirònov riesce a scamparla finché deruba anche un contadino, Stjepàn Pelaghèjuskin; quella volta il piano va storto e Ivàn viene arrestato. Pelaghèjuskin intima a Ivàn di dire dove ha nascosto la refurtiva, ma di fronte all'ostinato rifiuto lo uccide con una pietra, venendo condannato a una breve detenzione. Pjotr Nikolàjevic, in precedenza orgoglioso di non aver mai oppresso i contadini, subisce un cambiamento nel carattere dopo i furti subiti: divenuto diffidente e rigido sarà ucciso dai suoi contadini durante un tumulto. L'uccisione di Sventìtskij provoca due condanne a morte e, in seguito, all'imprigionamento di Tjùrin, uno studente socialista; la sua compagna Turcjàninova cercherà di vendicarlo preparando un attentato contro un ministro, ma finirà anch'essa in prigione. A sua volta, uscito di prigione, Stjepàn Pelaghèjuskin si dedica a furti e omicidi; durante una rapina Stjepàn uccide anche Màrja Semjònovna, una donna generosa e mite la quale cercava di mettere in pratica le Beatitudini evangeliche e che, assalita da Pelaghèjuskin, si preoccupa del suo assalitore. Seconda parte: Pelaghèjuskin, pentito dell'uccisione di Màrja Semjònovna, si costituisce. In carcere, ossessionato dai rimorsi, Pelaghèjuskin tenta di uccidersi; viene poi messo in cella con Vasìlij, condannato di nuovo per furto, e Cjùjev, un cristiano evangelico non violento, che si era convertito in seguito all'esempio di Màrja Semjònovna, ma era stato incarcerato per l'intervento del clero ortodosso. Anche Pelaghèjuskin si converte: si prodiga per aiutare gli altri reclusi, si sforza di leggere il Vangelo e infine si dedica anch'egli alla predicazione delle Beatitudini.

First Published in a single volume in 1883, the stories collected in Little Novels of Sicily are drawn from the Sicily of Giovanni Verga's childhood, reported at the time to be the poorest place in Europe. Verga's style is swift, sure, and implacable; he plunges into his stories almost in midbreath, and tells them with a stark economy of words. There's something dark and tightly coiled at the heart of each story, an ironic, bitter resolution that is belied by the deceptive simplicity of Verga's prose, and Verga strikes just when the reader's not expecting it. Translator D. H. Lawrence surely found echoes of his own upbringing in Verga's sketches of Sicilian life: the class struggle between property owners and tenants, the relationship between men and the land, and the unsentimental, sometimes startlingly lyric evocation of the landscape. Just as Lawrence veers between loving and despising the industrial North and its people, so too Verga shifts between affection for and ironic detachment from the superstitious, uneducated, downtrodden working poor of Sicily. If Verga reserves pity for anyone or anything, it is the children and the animals, but he doesn't spare them. In his experience, it is the innocents who suffer first and last and always.
