This book provides a review of the effectiveness of Opportunity to Learn (OTL) operationalized as the association between OTL and student achievement. In addition, it presents an elaborate conceptual map in which OTL is regarded as part of a larger concept of curriculum alignment. Major components of this framework are national goals and

standards, school curricula, formative tests, textbooks, actual delivery of content as part of teaching, and summative tests and examinations. Alignment between educational goals, intended and implemented curricula, and educational outcomes is considered an important prerequisite for effective education. The expectation is that better alignment leads to better student performance. The concept of OTL is commonly used to compare content covered, as part of the implemented curriculum, with student achievement. As such it is to be seen as a facet of the broader concept of "alignment". As it comes to enhancing OTL in educational policy and practice, proactive curriculum development is compared to a more retroactive orientation. Legitimate forms of test and examination preparation belong to this retroactive orientation, and are seen as favorable conditions for optimizing OTL. This book reviews the research evidence on the effects of OTL on student achievement by means of detailed descriptions of key-empirical studies, a review of meta-analyses, a "vote count" syntheses of 51 empirical studies, conducted between 1995 and 2015, and a secondary analysis based on TIMSS 2011, and PISA 2012 data. It concludes that the effect size of OTL, at about .30, is modest, but comparable in size to other effectiveness-enhancing conditions in schooling. The final chapter of the book provides suggestions for educational policy and practice to further optimize OTL. /div

This study addressed the effect of READ 180 on achievement levels, gender, and free and reduced lunch status on the English I End-of-Course assessment in an urban high school in the Middle Tennessee Region. The treatment sample included 32 ninth grade students, and

the control sample included 82 ninth grade students. A paired samples t test, chi square tests, and analysis of covariance tests were used to determine the effect of READ 180 on English I End-of-Course assessments for the students involved in this study. The results of this study indicated READ 180 was effective with the treatment group and is a reading intervention program one should consider for ninth grade students in high school.

This experimental study examined the Voyager Passport Reading Journeys program and its impact on 9th grade reading achievement. The 9th grade students selected for the program had performed at the basic or unsatisfactory level on the Kansas reading assessment, and/or performed below the fiftieth percentile on the Iowa Test of Educational Development, and/or received a Rasch Unit (RIT) score below 235 on the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment. The established score of 235 is considered by the test's authors to be below grade level. Ninety-five 9th grade students were recommended for the course. Of this number, 66 actually enrolled in the course with 29 selecting to not enroll. The students recommended and enrolled in the course were compared to those students recommended and not enrolled. In addition, a comparison was made between the students enrolled in the course and the students in 9th grade honors English and a separate comparison examined those in regular 9th grade English. The 9th grade students took a pretest at the beginning of the school year and a posttest at the end of the school year. This study was quantitative and consisted of data collected from the Measure of Academic Progress reading assessment. The simple analysis of variance (ANOVA) was used to analyze the reading scores. Within this analysis, the Bonferroni comparison provided the significant pair wise differences between the groups contributing to the overall significant difference between all four groups. Data analyzed from this study gave appropriate feedback as to the overall impact of the Voyager Passport Reading Journeys program on 9th grade reading achievement. While there was some improvement in the reading scores of those students participating in the program, the results were not significant.
