The Today Show's making hosting changes, the so-called "Late-Night Wars," O.J. Simpson's Bronco chase—Ebersol had a front-row seat to it all. Night to Sunday Night is filled with entertaining and illuminating stories featuring such boldface names as Billy Crystal, Michael Clinton, Jay Leno, Peyton Manning, Michael Phelps and Larry David. (Ebersol even inspired the famous Seinfeld episode in which Costanza pretends he didn't quit his job.) More than that, the book offers an insightful history and analysis of TV's evolution from cable and beyond—a must read for casual binge-watchers and small-screen aficionados alike.
