But most of them, though done with utmost sincerity, failed to create the emotional bond with the readers which the original*

There were many points of contention. There were issues where we could not reach a consensus easily. Finally the hard copy was ready for publication in 2016. The publisher had jitters and so did I. We got ready rough copies of two volumes. I gave it to two of my friends, who had read the original*
