Hans Roth was a member of the anti-tank panzerjager battalion, 299th Panzerjager Division, attached to the Sixth Army, as the invasion of Russia began. As events transpired, he recorded the tension and fear of the Germans deployed on the Soviet frontier in June 1941. Then, a firestorm broke loose as the Wehrmacht tore across the East, forging into the primitive vastness of the East. During the Kiev encirclement, Roth's unit was under constant attack and desperately tried to break through the German ring. At one point, after the enemy had finally been beaten, a friend of Roth's the SS led him to a site—possibly Babi Yar—where he witnessed civilians being massacred. After suffering through a grueling battle against apparently endless Russian reserves, his division went on the offensive again when the Germans drove toward

In these journals, attacks and counterattacks are described in you-are-there detail. Roth wrote privately, as if to keep knowing his honest accounts of the horrors in the East could never pass Wehrmacht censors. When the Soviet counteroffensive in winter 1942 begins, his unit is stationed alongside the Italian 8th Army, and his observations of its collapse, as opposed to the reaction of the German troops sent to stiffen its front, are of special fascination. Roth's three journals were discovered years after his disappearance, tucked away in the home of his brother. After his brother's death, his family discovered them and sent them to Rosel, Roth's wife. In time, Rosel handed down the journals to Erika, Roth's only daughter, who had emigrated to America. Roth was likely working on a fourth journal before he was reported missing in action in July 1944. Although his ultimate fate remains unknown, what he did leave behind, now finally revealed, is an incredible firsthand account of the war the Germans waged in Russia.

This is the ninth in the 300 series of circuit design books, again contains a wide range of circuits, tips and design ideas. The book has been divided into sections, making it easy to find related subjects in a single category. The book not only details DIY electronic circuits for home construction but also inspiring ideas for projects you may want to design from the ground up. Because software in general and microcontroller programming techniques in particular have become key aspects of modern electronics, a number of items in this book deal with these subjects only. Like its predecessors in the 300 series, "308 Circuits" covers the following disciplines and interest fields of modern electronics: test and measurement, radio and television, power supplies and battery chargers, general interest, computers and microprocessors, circuit ideas and audio and hi-fi.

This book is dedicated to Aristid Lindenmayer on the occasion of his 60th birthday on November 17, 1985. Contributions range from mathematics and theoretical computer science to biology. Aristid Lindenmayer introduced language-theoretic models for developmental biology in 1968. Since then the models have been customarily referred to as L systems. Lindenmayer's invention turned out to be one of the most beautiful examples of interdisciplinary science: work in one area (developmental biology) induces most fruitful ideas in other areas (theory of formal languages and automata, and formal power series). As evident from the articles and references in this book, the interest in L systems is continuously growing. For newcomers the first contact with L systems usually happens via the most basic class of L systems, namely, DOL systems. Here "0" stands for zero context between developing cells. It has been a major typographical problem that printers are unable to distinguish between 0 (zero) and o (oh). Thus, DOL was almost always printed with "oh" rather than "zero", and also pronounced that way. However, this misunderstanding turned out to be very fortunate. The wrong spelling "DOL" of "DOL" could be read in the suggestive way: DO L Indeed, hundreds of researchers have followed this suggestion. Some of them appear as contributors to this book. Of the many who could not contribute, we in particular regret the absence of A. Ehrenfeucht, G. Herman and H.A. Maurer whose influence in the theory of L systems has been most significant.
