Today it is still the main musical language of jazz musicians. Thus Swing to Bop reveals not only how the music evolved but the environment in which it flourished and what effect in turn the music had on that environment and the music to follow. He was previously Professor of Jazz History at City College of New York and Associate Editor of Downbeat.*
