The committee was charged with providing "advice to the CDC and the program investigators on selected aspects of the smallpox program

implementation and evaluation." The committee met six times over 19 months and wrote a series of brief "letter" reports. The Smallpox Vaccination Program: Public Health in an Age of Terrorism constitutes the committee's seventh and final report, and the committee hopes that it will fulfill three purposes:

- 1) To serve as an archival document that brings together the six reports addressed to Julie Gerberding, director of CDC, and previously**

released on line and as short, unbound papers; 2) To serve as a historical document that summarizes milestones in the smallpox vaccination program, and ; 3) To comment on the achievement of overall goals of the smallpox vaccination program (in accordance with the last item in the charge), including lessons learned from the program.
