Sigismund Schlomo Freud was born on 6th May 1856, in the Moravian town of Přebor, now part of the Czech Republic. He studied a variety of subjects, including philosophy, physiology, and zoology, graduating with an MD in 1881. Freud made a huge and lasting contribution to the field of psychology with many of his methods still being used in modern psychoanalysis. He inspired much discussion on the wealth of theories he produced and the reactions to his works began a century of great psychological investigation.

Topology is a branch of pure mathematics that deals with the abstract relationships found in geometry and analysis.
