The life and work of Maryanne Amacher are as vast as they are as yet unknown. Situated at the onset of serious study of her papers, Amy Cimini and Bill Dietz offer a heterodox and idiosyncratic selection of largely unpublished documents spanning the bandwidth of the still unprocessed contents of the Amacher archive. The book assembles staggeringly rich primary material and at the same time asks what it takes to assemble those materials while the ground is still very much shifting under the question: What is Maryanne Amacher?? Because Amacher worked across nearly every imaginable media format, this book will be of tremendous interest to theorists and practitioners in media and communication studies, urban design, contemporary art history, music studies, sound studies, film, radio, art criticism, and performance studies—in short, the burgeoning configuration of disciplines that we might call a new intermedial humanities.'

Even with just forty-one recordings to his credit, Robert Johnson (1911-38) is a towering figure in the history of the blues. His vast influence on twentieth-century American music, combined with his mysterious death at the age of twenty-seven, still encourage the speculation and myth that have obscured the facts about his life. The most famous legend depicts a young Johnson meeting a devil on a dusty Mississippi crossroads at midnight and selling his soul in exchange for prodigious guitar skills. Barry Lee Pearson and Bill McCulloch examine the full range of writings about Johnson and weigh conflicting accounts of Johnson's life story against interviews with blues musicians and other contemporaries of the man. Their extensive research uncovers a life every bit as compelling as the fabrications and exaggerations that have sprung up around it. In examining the bluesman's life and music, and the ways in which both have been reinvented and interpreted by other artists, critics, and fans, Robert

Lost and Found charts the cultural forces that have mediated the expression of African American traditions.
