Hamessley further provides an understanding of how Parton combines her cultural and musical heritage with an artisan's sense of craft and design to compose eloquent, painfully honest, and gripping songs about women's lives, poverty, heartbreak, inspiration, and love. Filled with insights on hit songs and less familiar gems, *Unlikely Angel* covers the full arc of Dolly Parton's career and offers an unprecedented look at the creative force behind the image.
