Warriors of the Plains explores the art of North American Plains Indian warriors - weapons, amulets, clothing and ceremonial objects - with particular emphasis on their ritual use and symbolic meanings. Unlike most books on Plains Indians, which have a purely historical focus, this title examines continuity and change between historic warrior societies and contemporary Native American military associations. Originally set up as clubs to organise war raids and to police seasonal cycles of nomadic hunting, warrior societies today maintain much of the Plains Indians' ethos, vigorously reinforcing their cultural, national and ethnic identity. With a new approach to the subject the author reveals how specific items and symbols - objects of "ritual and honour" - such as the American flag, eagle feathers and medicine bundles have been used over the last 200 years, as well as exploring the introduction of new elements in modern ceremonial practices such as powwow dance competitions and war veterans' celebrations. Lavishly illustrated with objects from the British Museum's important collections, as well as archival material, this book features previously unpublished material. Max Carocci has been conducting research on Plains Indians since 1989. Since 2006 he has been researching and collecting in this area for the British Museum and is the curator of the touring exhibition "Warriors of the Plains: 200 years of Native North American honour and ritual". He lectures on Indigenous American Arts at Birkbeck College, University of London and is editor of the Anthropological Index Online run by the Royal Anthropological Institute.

Power Beyond Scrutiny uncovers the forces which distort and limit public debate in the media. From the misuse of politician's expenses to recent phone hacking scandals, establishment corruption has never been more in the headlines. The book describes the different aspects of the economy from the role of the World Trade Organization to the workings of financial markets, and the actions of the International Monetary Fund and the Group of Twenty nations. It explains the underlying changes that have affected individuals in their various roles as consumers, producers, workers and citizens around the world, and identifies the challenges for sustainable economic growth in the years ahead. It also examines the underside of globalization, including human trafficking, sweatshops, organized crime, unsafe products, and environmental destruction.

High temperature electrolysis (HTE), which is the highly efficient electrolysis of steam at high temperature and utilises the heat and electrical power supplied by advanced nuclear reactor, provides a very promising way for massive production of hydrogen in the future. This book provides an overview of HTE technology including its key characteristics and challenges of solid oxide electrolysis cell (SOEC) development. This book also examines the theory of electrical double layer, which is an essential electrochemical problem. The phenomenological theory of interfacial phenomena is also explored, with consideration of surface polarisation. Furthermore, the electrochemical reduction of nitrate has a great importance mainly for environmental and analytical purposes. This book provides a review of 225 papers dealing with the electrochemical reduction of nitrate. Other chapters introduce the application of electrochemical method for treatment of domestic wastewater and industrial wastewater, propose a novel point of view concerning some theoretical and practical aspects of isoelectric focusing, describe the electrochemical oxidation of strontium chloride (SrCl₂) to strontium chlorate employing a noble metal oxide coated anode and rotating stainless steel cathode, and report a preparation method suitable for requirements of industrial applications to graft active polymer films. Experimental studies on electrodeposition of silver-indium (Ag-In) alloys are also described, as well as the application of the electrochemical discharge phenomenon to synthetic chemistry, nanoparticle synthesis and micromachining.
