Tabatha even shows readers how to turn these clever creatures into hand puppets. After fun with of couple of precious pooches, it’s time for Nostalgic Posing Dolls named Ruru, Lili, Lala-chan, and a lovely little Fawn. In the Accessories section, Tabatha includes Hanging Charms (beaded strands with little figures such as birds, cats, fish, frogs, and cookies); Fun Coasters in the shapes of a frog, a fish, and a chick; Eyeglass Cases; and Pouches. There are small and large tote bags, each with an appealing animal appliqué; and an assortment of brooches shaped like the faces of favorites like a koala, a piglet, a panda, a pug, and more. Every project features clear, step-by-step instructions accompanied by beautiful full-color photographs and cut-out patterns. Plus, an explanatory section covers the basic stitches and techniques used. Everything is hand-stitched – no sewing machines, tools, or intricate steps are required. Simple enough for crafters ranging in age from about ten years old to adult, More Felt Friends from Japan is sure to please anyone who loves creating cute things from felt.

This paper doll book was inspired by Johanna Spyri's "Heidi," one of the most, if not THE most, popular pieces of Swiss literature ever written. The illustrations in this book are paintings (watercolor and digital coloring), which lovingly detail Heidi's story, from her delight with the beauties of her mountain home to her adventures in the big city of Frankfurt. The set includes 7 dolls (6.5"-8.5"), 12 animals, 22 costumes, and over 70 accessories, as well as two 3-page background settings ("Grandfather's House" and "Mountain Pastures"). The illustrations were inspired by clothing and culinary details of the 1800s and of Switzerland. This book was published through Amazon KDP. The paper weight is slightly thicker than ordinary printer paper. The paper weight is the same for both doll/s and costume/s. The artist recommends backing the doll/s with cardstock if a thicker doll is desired (the doll and costumes function perfectly without the added thickness, however).
