Much deeper and far more edifying than a collection of platitudes or lighthearted fable, Make Your Own Damn Cheese is the kind of read that people love--especially those who enjoyed the first two tales of mazes and mice who conquer their fears and learn to adapt. There, he learns what cheese really is and why it is important, and he also learns that he is really a human being and not a mouse at all--he has the power of choice, free will, and decision-making. He is joyfully astonished to learn that he does not have to spend his life chasing cheese--he learns to make his own damn cheese!
