Abstract: Information on insects, weeds, and diseases of field and forage crops and their control, integrated pest management (IPM), application equipment and calibration, and on factors influencing pesticide performance is provided in this manual. Designed to prepare individuals seeking certification as Commercial or Public Field Crop Pest Control Applicators for this license category examination, this manual contains study questions, a glossary, suggested additional reading, conversions and dilution tables, and color photographs. Specific pesticide recommendations for controlling field and forage crop pests are not included because they are published in annually revised University of Illinois circulars and fact sheets.
