The good news is that the equity market will be the next big positive investments in the foreseeable future; most professional investors will be betting on the market for a tremendous gain on their portfolio in the coming months and years. You have to profit in this upcoming boom of the stock market. However, if you are not armed to the teeth with trading strategy, you will be trading against those hedge fund managers, professional traders at investment bank trading desks, and option trading gurus who would be gladly make money off your trading mistakes. After all, it is a fair game of zero-sum; your loss is someone else's gain. So, you must have a trading strategy that is simple, precise, effective, and most importantly safe (relatively speaking). You must apply all your knowledge and endeavor to learn new methods to protect your investment while trading. For most people, the stock market over last ten years, has been either flat or down.
