It's essential to uncover the current malady affecting the organized Christian Church today, not its structuring and

not necessarily its organizational approach, but present to it His solution, which has never been hidden or even veiled in His Word, which is that we must return to the true roots of Christianity, which is founded on the individual discipleship of each member of His body, just as Jesus designed it and modeled it for us while He ministered on this earth. It passed the acid test of resiliency when it was mercilessly persecuted, as its disciples applied the principles as instituted and instructed by our Lord for all of us to display and to do. I encourage anyone to do a Bible search for the word "disciple" and "believer" and see firsthand that these words are not interchangeable or used in the same context when referring to a specific person who's known to be committed to our Lord, versus referring to a generalization in the third person to someone or a group who's aware about the existence of the real living God. God's remedy it's still available today to anyone who truly desires to attain it and can decipher that it's only through discipleship that a true believer is infected with the enthusiasm, zeal, and eagerness in the commitment to fulfill John 8:31 and Matthew 28:19, reaching to those around them who thirst and hunger for the things of God, and in that process, experience the life He promises we can live now. It's time to abandon, once and for all, the current practices of mass-producing "supporters," and inscribe it into our minds that the Great Commission was not to make believers but to make disciples. The early church didn't churn out cheerleaders and advocates but bona fide disciples, taught and equipped according to Ephesians 6:10-17, who then, as members of the body of Christ, led by example, transforming them into a formidable, most powerful and effective force the Roman Empire had ever seen. Again, I want to reiterate that I am not against the church, as organized by the apostles, but want to revolutionize it, where discipleship is the top priority and purpose for its existence. I am critical of the current organized version that has taken the place of the real church, that nowadays is wasting vast resources and investing them in huge entertainment amphitheatres, and often dilute, distort, and obscure the true message and method to attain this new life established by our Lord. Unless this change happens, we can't truly reach and change a lost world. Our Real Life in Christ seeks to help those who are experiencing that gnawing

sensation that there is much more to God's Word than what is being offered by those weekly sermons in churches today. It's never too late. Whether you're a new Christian or you've walked the road for decades, it's never too late to find the critical truths that make life make sense. We often start out believing that common sense will be enough, that we're prepared for the road ahead with our good values and quick thinking. It doesn't take long to learn otherwise. A broken friendship. An obsessive career. Financial distress. Even empty success. We come back to God, searching for insight, for hope. And He provides. Nothing can replace studying the Bible. Best-selling author and pastor Charles Swindoll has spent decades studying its pages and teaching its precepts. But if sixty-six books seem overwhelming, *The Owner's Manual for Christians* is the perfect starting place: a biblical summary of the major truths that anchor the Christian life. We look at a few things; become acquainted with a few elementary principles; make a little progress in virtue, and then all our studies and efforts are suspended, and "we fly away." Just about everyone will face a difficult bioethics decision at some point. In this book a theologian, ethicist, and lawyer equips Christians to make such decisions based on biblical truth, wisdom, and virtue. Though a relatively new discipline, bioethics has generated extraordinary interest due to a number of socially pressing issues. Bioethics and the Christian Life places bioethics within the holistic context of the Christian life, both developing a general Christian approach to making bioethics decisions and addressing a number of specific, controversial areas of bioethics. The title of the book, The X-Manual, is taken from the word exousia, from the subtitle. It is the Greek word for authority. The word is used throughout the New Testament. For our purposes, it is used to express the divine authority or right to cast out demons—"I have given you authority [exousia] to trample on snakes and scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; nothing will harm you" (Luke 10:19 NIV). Jesus gives believers authority to cast out demons. This book is about spiritual authority over evil. The X-Manual is a practical "how to" handbook for clergy and laity on deliverance and exorcism. One reason I wrote the book is because so few understand and/or operate effectively in deliverance ministry. Nowhere is the

church more inadequate or excessive than in deliverance ministry. The X-Manual contains specific time-tested biblical instructions on selecting and training a deliverance team, pre-deliverance work, the deliverance session, post-deliverance work, and other useful tools like the C1-13 instrument that helps determine if one needs deliverance. Deliverance is essential to the church's New Testament healing and evangelism ministry. It is time for the church to walk in the authority and power that Christ gave us to set the captives free! Religion brings judgment and isolation. *Maximizing the Armor of God*, along with four other books; *The Art of Spiritual Warfare*, *The Five Offices*, *New Revelations on Revelations* and *The Kings in Christ's Kingdom* make up a five book series. This series allows us to take the logistics of the *Armor of God*, combined with harnessing our thoughts, to give us impenetrable Spiritual Armor of God to the Nth Degree.

Dr. Brian Bailey presents this commentary on the epistle to the Ephesians, which beautifully portrays Christ as the warrior King, clothed with the armor of God. This same armor is available to us by His grace so that we too may be victorious over the enemy. It is the author's prayer that the readers might enter into these beautiful truths that we might be raised up to "sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus." (2:6)
