*Chiara Petrillo was seated in a wheel chair looking lovingly toward Jesus in the tabernacle. Her husband, Enrico, found the courage to ask her a question that he had been holding back. Thinking of Jesus's phrase, "my yoke is sweet and my burden is light," he asked: "Is this yoke, this cross, really sweet, as Jesus said?" A smile came across Chiara's face. She turned to her husband and said in a weak voice: "Yes, Enrico, it is very sweet." At 28 years old, Chiara passed away, her body ravaged by cancer. The emotional, physical, and spiritual trials of this young Italian mother are not uncommon. It was her joyful and loving response to each that led one cardinal to call her "a saint for our times." Chiara entrusted her first baby to the blessed Virgin, but felt as though this child was not hers to keep. Soon, it was revealed her*

daughter had life-threatening abnormalities. Despite universal pressure to abort, Chiara gave birth to a beautiful girl who died within the hour. A year later, the death of her second child came even more quickly. Yet God was preparing their hearts for more—more sorrow and more grace. While pregnant a third time, Chiara developed a malignant tumor. She refused to jeopardize the life of her unborn son by undergoing treatments during the pregnancy. Chiara waited until after Francesco was safely born, and then began the most intense treatments of radiation and chemotherapy, but it was soon clear that the cancer was terminal. Almost immediately after giving birth to Francesco, Chiara's tumor became terminal and caused her to lose the use of her right eye. Her body was tested, and so was her soul as she suffered through terrible dark nights. She said "yes" to everything God sent her way, becoming a true child of God. And as her days on earth came to an end, Enrico looked down on his wife and said, "If she is going to be with Someone who loves her more than I, why should I be upset?" Each saint has a special charisma, a particular facet of God that is reflected through her. Chiara's was to be a witness to joy in the face of great adversity, the kind which makes love overflow despite the sorrow from loss and death.

*The Visio Pauli and the Gnostic Apocalypse of Paul is the first modern collection of studies on the most important aspects of the Visio Pauli, the most popular early Christian apocalypse in the Middle Ages. The volume starts with a short study of the textual traditions of the Visio Pauli, its Jewish and early Christian traditions as well as its influence on later literature, such as Dante. This is followed by studies of the Prologue, the four rivers of Eden, the place of the Ocean, the relation between body and soul, the image of hell and its punishments, and the connection with fantastic literature. Finally, a codicological, comparative, and textual re-evaluation of the Coptic translation attempts to correct earlier errors and to rehabilitate the value and interest of this long neglected version of the Visio Pauli. The book is concluded with a study of the earthly tribunal in the fourth heaven of the Gnostic Apocalypse of Paul. As has become customary, the volume is rounded off by an extensive bibliography of the Visio Pauli and the Gnostic Apocalypse of Paul and a detailed index.*

On 23 April 1943, Good Friday, Maria Valtorta reported hearing the voice of Jesus. From then until 1951 she produced over 15,000 handwritten pages in 122 notebooks, mostly detailing the life of Jesus as an extension of the gospels. Her handwritten notebooks containing close to 700 reputed episodes in the life of Jesus were typed on separate pages by her priest and reassembled, given that they had no temporal order, and became the basis of her 5,000-page book *The Poem of the Man God*.

Neste Compêndio Iremos ver que a catequese é o ensinamento essencial da fé. Quando se fala em catequese, muitos pensam naquela que prepara as crianças para a Primeira Eucaristia ou a Crisma. Engana-se quem acha que catequese é o mesmo que "dar catecismo", pois ela faz parte da ação evangelizadora da Igreja que envolve aqueles que aderem a Jesus Cristo. Catequese é o ensinamento essencial da fé, não apenas da doutrina, como também da vida, levando a uma consciente e ativa participação do mistério litúrgico e irradiando uma ação apostólica. Segundo o documento de Puebla e a afirmação dos Bispos do Brasil, a catequese é um processo de educação da fé em comunidade, é dinâmica, é sistemática e permanente. O Papa João Paulo II disse: "A catequese é uma educação da fé das crianças, dos jovens e dos adultos, a qual compreende especialmente um ensino da doutrina cristã, dado em geral de maneira orgânica e sistemática, com fim de iniciá-los na plenitude da vida cristã" (CT). Segundo o Novo Catecismo da Igreja Católica (1992), "no centro da catequese encontramos essencialmente uma Pessoa, a de Jesus Cristo de Nazaré, Filho único do Pai (...)". Portanto veremos que a finalidade definitiva da catequese é levar à comunhão com Jesus Cristo: só Ele pode conduzir ao Amor do Pai no Espírito e fazer-nos participar da vida da Santíssima Trindade. Todo catequista deveria poder aplicar a si mesmo a misteriosa Palavra de Jesus: 'Minha doutrina não é minha, mas daquele que me enviou' (Jo 7,16)" (NCIC, 426-427). Vamos meditar que, em sua origem, o termo "catequese" diz respeito à proclamação da Palavra. O termo se liga a um

verbo que significa “Fazer”, “Ecoar” (gr. Kat-ekhéo). Assim, ela tem por objetivo último fazer escutar e repercutir a Palavra de Deus. A catequese faz parte da ação evangelizadora da Igreja, que envolve aqueles que aderem a Jesus Cristo. Catequese é o ensinamento essencial da fé, não apenas da doutrina como também da vida, levando a uma consciente e ativa participação do mistério litúrgico e irradiando uma ação apostólica

Acts and Monuments by John Foxe, popularly abridged as Foxe's Book of Martyrs, is a celebrated work of church history and martyrology, first published in English in 1563 by John Day. Published early in the reign of Queen Elizabeth I and only five years after the death of the Roman Catholic Queen Mary I, Foxe's Acts and Monuments was an affirmation of the Protestant Reformation in England during a period of religious conflict between Catholics and Protestants. Foxe's account of church history asserted a historical justification that was intended to establish the Church of England as a continuation of the true Christian church rather than as a modern innovation, and it contributed significantly to a nationalistic repudiation of the Roman Catholic Church. The sequence of the work, initially in five books, covered first early Christian martyrs, a brief history of the medieval church, including the Inquisitions, and a history of the Wycliffite or Lollard movement. It then dealt with the reigns of Henry VIII and Edward VI, during which the dispute with Rome had led to the separation of the English Church from papal authority and the issuance of the Book of Common Prayer. Paradoxically, as 1954 came to an end William Branham was not satisfied. To remedy this problem, Bill felt led to teach more doctrine in his evangelistic campaigns, explaining the fundamentals of the Christian faith. This decision produced some unexpected results. During 1955, attendance at his faith-healing campaigns declined sharply. Evidently, people welcomed miracles as long as they didn't have to change their own ideas. Some people felt he should concentrate on divine healing and leave the teaching to the pastors, or teachers who had more education.
