This volume presents an original commentary for Al-Tadhkirah (The Memorandum), a legal primer for Islamic Law according to the later scholars of the Shʻfiʻ school by Ibn al-Mulaqqin, an Egyptian scholar who died in 804AH/1401CE. The commentary introduces essential evidence for the core issues of Islamic Law from its primary sources (the Quran, Sunnah, legal analogy, and scholarly consensus). The commentary is based on Ibn al-Mulaqqin’s legal commentaries (Sharʻ Mukhtaʻar al-Tabrʻrʻzʻ, Khulʻʻat al-fatʻwʻ, and ʻUjʻʻat al-muʻʻtʻj) and works on legal hadiths (Tuʻʻfat al-muʻʻtʻj, Mukhtaʻar al-Badr al-munʻʻr, and Al-Badr al-nunʻʻr). The Evident Memorandum helps explain why Islamic Law includes specific topics and the essential evidence behind the Shʻfiʻ school’s opinion. It will be most beneficial to readers who are already familiar with Islamic Law and jurisprudence.

By focusing on specific sites, such as virtual borders in airports, trusted traveller programs like the NEXUS program and those delivered by airlines and supported by governmental authorities (TSA and CATSA respectively), this book raises critical questions about the emerging biometric state and its commitment and constitution vis-à-vis technology of 'governing through risk'. This book will be of interest to students of biopolitics, critical security, surveillance studies and International Relations in general. Benjamin J.
