This paper reviews the existing indices on anti-trafficking policy and proposes the integration of statistical indicators into the indices coded from qualitative texts in order to improve the objectivity of evaluation. Examining the validity of the existing indices, the 3P Index and the GRETA-Scorecard, the results suggest that these measurements are not free from subjectivity regarding the selection of policy requirements and evaluation standards. To enhance objectivity, the utilization of the European Statistics is proposed and the validity of these statistics is investigated through multi-covariate analysis. The results show that the EU statistics are relevant indicators reflecting the quality of anti-trafficking policy, suggesting that, by integrating text and statistical information, an index on anti-trafficking policy can enhance its comprehensiveness and objectivity

The recent evaluation outcome of the 3P Anti-Trafficking Policy Index shows that many countries fail to provide proper protection for victims of human trafficking. Furthermore, prosecution efforts have recently declined worldwide due to negligence in enforcement. These findings suggest that the policy focus of human rights and the actual implementation of written law are central to successfully achieving anti-trafficking objectives.

Objectives: The objectives of this article are to review existing indices on anti-trafficking policy and to propose a way to improve the policy indices. **Methods:** The four existing indices -- the 3P Index, the GRETA-based Scorecard, the EuroStat, and the U.S. Tier-Ranking -- were compared regarding their contents, quantification methods, and the coverage of the data. In particular, the validity of the first two indices coded from qualitative information was examined through tests for linear correlation, and the content of the EuroStat was evaluated by multivariate regression analyses. **Results:** Empirical results show that the evaluation outcomes of the 3P Index and the Scorecard are considerably different, arguably because of the noncomprehensive selection of policy requirements and subjective judgments in interpreting qualitative texts. On the other hand, EuroStat seems to measure the quality of anti-trafficking policy and therefore these statistics can be used as relevant indicators of policy evaluation. **Conclusion:** The empirical investigation of this article suggests that integrating textual and statistical information can be a way to improve the quality of an index evaluating anti-trafficking policy.

The 3P-index (prevention, Protection, 'or' Prosecution), a Revised Approach to Forced Labour, Compliance and Enforcement: A Systematic Review

This edited volume focuses on charting the rise of neo-abolitionism and offering a critique of the idea, its logics and consequences. A model of state policy which aims to abolish prostitution through legislation, Neo-abolitionism criminalises the buyer of sex but not the seller. It is currently law in Sweden and other Nordic states and dominates the framing of policy debates in many other Western liberal contexts. Pressure for adoption of this policy has come from radical feminists who understand prostitution and sex trafficking as a form of violence against women. This volume argues that this convergence between radical feminism and state's interests arises from the emergence of, on the one hand, 'governance feminism' which seeks to have its ideals implemented through 'top-down sovereigntist means', and on the other hand, state's interests in legitimising stricter border controls and law enforcement responses in relation to transnational organised criminality, 'illegal' migration, and security. Based around a series of country case studies each chapter will explore the politics surrounding the emergence of neo-abolitionism and its trajectory through those politics, whether the paradigm has been adopted, rejected or is still under debate. The volume will be of great interest to students and scholars of Social and Public Policy, Gender and Women's Studies, Politics and International Relations and Critical Legal Studies/Criminology.
