Mentally disturbed people did not fare much better even when the witchhunting days were gone. John Christian Reil gave the following description of mental patients at the crossroads of the fifteenth and sixteenth centuries: We incarcerate

Their fetters have eaten off the flesh of their bones, and their emaciated pale faces look expectantly toward the graves which will end their misery and cover up our shamefulness. (1803) The great reforms introduced by Philippe Pinel at Bicetre in 1793 augured the beginning of a new approach. Pinel ascribed the "sick role," and called for compassion and help. One does not need to know much about those he wants to hurt, but one must know a lot in order to help.
