The purpose of this study was to examine the impact of Automated Regional Information System (ARJIS) on the performance of law enforcement officers. The officers in the San Diego County Sheriff's Office (SDSO) served as the focus of the study. The methodology consisted of surveys, interviews, and direct observation, the purpose of which was to assess attitudes and perception of the value of information technology to patrol officers and detectives. This was

supplemented by a review of records. The comparison group, used as a control for this research, consisted of officers from a sheriff's office in the southeastern part of the United States who do not have access to regional information sharing technology on the scale of ARJIS. The survey sample consisted of 588 officers, split between agencies. This research determined if and how information-sharing technology helps law enforcement by examining the differences in perception of the value

of IT between the law enforcement officers who have access to automated regional information sharing (i.e., the study group in San Diego) and those who do not (i.e., the comparison group). The study also examined whether the extent and type of computer training influenced the officers' perception of the value of information technology.
