The blending resulted within the present day Eurasier, even though the breed became at first referred to as the Wolf Chow. In 1973, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an worldwide federation of country wide kennel clubs, diagnosed the breed because the Eurasier, a call that became selected to mirror each their European and Asian backgrounds. They distinguish the breed as a Spitz or Primitive kind.

My ultimate goal is to enable children to feel comfortable around dogs so their lives aren't disrupted by the fear of them.
