Former players have described him as "scary," as a "volcano." The former Barcelona president described him as "the devil himself." At Bayern, they said he "vaangalised" their team. And yet at the same time, he is "warm-blooded." He openly admits: "I cry almost every day. There's always something that touches me." Barcelona's Xavi says of him: "People see him as arrogant and aloof but he's really not." Dutch Courage is a detailed dissection of the truth behind the myth of Van Gaal, studying his philosophy and his character, as well as some of the excellent football teams he has produced. This Dutch master has been the head of some of the greatest dynasties in European football - Ajax, Barcelona, Bayern Munich, and Manchester United - as well as the boss of the Netherlands national team (twice). Along the way, he has won a combined seven league championships across Europe. He has also been successful in continental competitions, listing the Champions League, the UEFA Cup, and the UEFA Super Cup amongst his honours. As head coach of the Netherlands in the 2014 World Cup, he led them to within a whisker of the final, beating world champions Spain 5-1 along the way, before his young Dutch charges were finally beaten on penalties by Argentina in the semi-final. But in 2014 he took on arguably his greatest challenge: restoring Manchester United to their perch after a year in the doldrums. Since a number critics have called this novel "[...] the most authentic book [...] about football hooligans [...]" (Mark Piggot, Rasp!), it is the aim of this paper to show this authenticity and therefore, to compare features of real life hooliganism in Britain with the British hooliganism shown in the novel "Football Factory." Three aspects of British hooliganism will therefore be looked at closer in order to show the novel's authenticity. Firstly, one will encounter an introductory chapter about the novel "Football Factory" (2.), followed by introductory aspects about the nature of British hooliganism and their characteristic features like the 'alcohol-violence connection' based on sociological studies (3.1.). Secondly, in the main part of this paper, the reader will be made familiar with the phenomenon of British tabloid press coverage of British hooliganism with the help of war comparisons (4.1.) and the representation of the press and its war comparisons in "Football Factory" (4.2.). Finally, the impact of women in general and female supporters on this male dominion of British football culture (5.1.) and the role of women and the making of male identities in the novel (5.2.), before a conclusion (6.) will summarize the results.

(Sir Norman Chester Centre for Football Research 2001: 1) Thus, there is no doubt that typical attitudes and emotions representing "true masculinity" (Holt 1989: 8), such as the celebration of physical strength and the loyalty to ‘mates’ or to a specific territory, are traditional and popular features of football culture. [Since meanwhile, the male-dominated subculture of football hooligans has not only grown to a serious problem in England but also in many other countries around Europe, football-related antisocial behaviour has become a subject to much discussion about masculinity and subcultures in the fields of academics and the media over the past several years and decades. Consequently, my paper aims at presenting football hooliganism as a male subculture with its own values and rituals, which are clearly different from those of our dominant culture, and, furthermore, it tries to analyse what images of masculinity are associated with the subculture of – particularly English – football hooligans. Therefore, my paper will first provide some important theoretical background information about hooligans, which are necessary in order to get into the topic of football hooliganism more elaborately. Then, it will analyse why hooligans belong to a certain form of subculture by presenting and explaining specific characteristics, attitudes and behaviour patterns of football hooligans, and, finally, it shall explore what kind of masculinity is represented by the football hooligans described in John King’s novel The Football Factory.
