Each paper, without the authors' information, was reviewed by at least three members of the program committee, and the papers (co-)authored by members of the program commit were reviewed by at least six members. We also blinded the reviewers' names among the

reviewers until the ?nal decision, by using pseudonyms. The reviews were then followed by decisions on the papers, which greatly contributed to the quality of the ?nal selection. In make cases, extensive comments were sent to the authors. Among 208 submissions, the program committee selected 36 papers. Two submissions were merged into a single paper, yielding the of 35 papers acceptedforpresentation in the technical program of the conference. Manyhi- quality works could not be accepted because of the competitive nature of the conference and the challenging task of selecting a program. These proceedings contain revised versions of the accepted papers. These revisions have not been checked for correctness, and the authors bear responsibility for the contents of their papers.

The total of 156 papers presented in this three-volume set was carefully reviewed and selected from 490 submissions. The topic areas for the selected papers include information retrieval, search and recommendation techniques; RDF, knowledge graphs, semantic web, and knowledge management; and spatial, temporal, sequence, and streaming data management, while the dominant keywords are network, recommendation, graph, learning, and model. These topic areas and keywords shed the light on the direction where the research in DASFAA is moving towards. Due to the Corona pandemic this event was held virtually.

Contributed articles presented at the Conference.

The third International Conference on Provable Security (ProvSec 2009) was held in Guangzhou, China, November 11-13, 2009. It continued the theme of ProvableSecurity initiated by the ProvSec2007 conference in Wollongong, A- tralia. The second ProvSec conference was organized in Shanghai, China. The conference was sponsored by the Center for Advanced Computing -

Cryptog- phy and Algorithms (ACAC), Macquarie University, Australia; Guangdong Key Laboratory of Information Security Technology, Sun Yat-sen University, China; andthe NationalNaturalScienceFoundationofChina (NSFC). JiwuHuangwas the General Chair and we, Josef Pieprzyk and Fangquo Zhang, were Program Co-chairs. The conference proceedings have been published by Springer in this volume of Lecture Notes in Computer Science. The Program Committee invited two distinguished researchers to deliver their keynote talks. The ?rst speaker was Alex Dent from Royal Holloway, University of London. His talk was entitled "A Brief History of Security Models for Con?dentiality". The second speaker was Bogdan Warinschi from the University of Bristol, UK, who presented a talk on "Symbolic Methods for Provable Security". We received 64 papers. Each paper was assigned to three referees. Papers submitted by the members of the Program Committee were assigned to ?ve referees. In the ?rst stage of the review process, the submitted papers were readand evaluated bythe PCmembers and then in the secondstage, the papers werescrutinizedduringanextensivedi scussion. Finally, the Program Committee chose 19 papers to be

included in the conference program. The authors of the accepted papers had three weeks for revision and preparation of ?nal versions.
